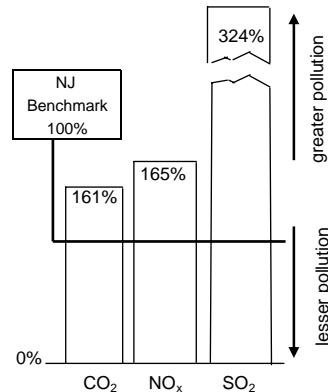
#### Air Emissions

The amount of air pollution associated with the generation of the electricity product is shown. This amount is compared to a New Jersey benchmark. The benchmark approximates the average emission rate for all electricity generation in New Jersey.

Carbon Dioxide, or CO<sub>2</sub> is a "greenhouse gas" which may contribute to global climate change. Sulfur Oxides, or SO<sub>2</sub>, and Nitrogen Dioxides, or NO<sub>x</sub>, react to form acids found in acid rain. NO<sub>x</sub> also reacts to form ground level ozone, an unhealthy component of "smog."

#### Energy Conservation
